The latest 12th generation Toyota Corolla, has been launched locally to offer an upmarket option to South Africa buyers of the world's top-selling car nameplate. Here in SA we already have the extended-life Corolla Quest, which was rejuvenated earlier this year. The value-for-money Quest continues to dominate its segment, selling 718 units in June compared to the 112 examples of the latest Corolla which were sold in that month.



The Hyundai Tucson is being given a big marketing push in these times of lockdown and it is paying benefits. A total of 494 Tucsons were sold in June, which saw it overtake Volkswagen's popular Tiguan in the SUV category. Tiguan sold 378 units in the month.

The Isuzu D-Max had a stellar sales month in June, outselling the Ford Ranger to take second place in the hotly-contested one-ton bakkie segment, behind the Toyota Hilux. The Isuzu sold 1 669 units for a market share of 16.3%, compared to Ranger's 1 242 sales (12.2%) and Hilux's 3 131 sales and 30.6% penetration.
